summary:

In 2007, the City of Vancouver formed a stakeholder committee to help inform the new master planning process for Hastings Park. Community Studio was asked to sit on this committee as a city-wide representative to promote a sustainable design perspective.

Hastings Park was originally given to the City by the Province in 1889, making it almost as old as Vancouver itself. At 66 hectares, it is one of Vancouver's largest urban parks. The site includes Empire Fields, the PNE, the Pacific Coliseum, the Hastings Racetrack, and mix of commercial and community buildings, and 11 hectares of green space.
